SYLLABUS AND MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

The school follows the CBSE syllabus and the medium of instruction is English. Hindi, Malayalam and Sanskrit are also taught at different levels. Academic year starts from 1st June and ends by 31st March. The students who seek admission to Senior Secondary class can choose either Science or Commerce stream as follows :
